- ~ Use spaces to show division between ideas, concepts, or sections

3 - "Main Ideas" column

- ~ Summarize the main ideas
- ~ List key words or phrases, you can also draw pictures in this column
- ~ Use this column as a quick study guide

4 - "Summary" section

- ~ Use this to provide a concise summary of what you read
- ~ This section will serve as a quick study guide
