Make a list of
things that are
green like clovers

Play, "Head and Shoulders, Knees and Toes", change it by substituting different body parts Act out the story of your favorite book; what happened in the beginning, middle, and end?

Build a fort with blankets; talk about what items you need and how you will build it

Make homemade Play-Doh, talk about each step

Paint a picture of a rainbow, label the materials you are using and each paint color Arrange toilet paper rolls like bowling pins; use socks to knock down the pins, talk about what happened

While at the grocery store, find five different fruits and label them

Read a St. Patrick's Day book; identify five new vocabulary words to talk about Fold the laundry together, sort clothes by color or item; label the clothing items

Make green pancakes for St. Patrick's Day; visit moogcenter.org for language ideas

Take a walk through your home, label each room in your house Make a cup of green milk for St. Patrick's Day, talk about each step

Have a tea party, label each item as

you place it on the table

Recite the nursery rhyme, "Hey, Diddle Diddle" and then act it out with props

Perform a puppet show; make your own puppets or use stuffed animals, have the characters talk to each other Gather items from each room of the house; talk about where each item belongs and where you will put it

Sweep the floor together; talk about what you are doing Sort the books on your bookshelf from tallest to shortest; talk about their size

Label each piece of equipment while playing on the playground

Visit your local fire station; label the fire equipment and talk about fire safety

Draw with sidewalk chalk; talk about the shapes you are drawing and their sizes

Go on a bug hunt; talk about the bugs you find and where you find them

Help your child fix a broken item or toy; talk about how it broke and how you will fix it Plant a seed in a pot, predict what you think will happen
