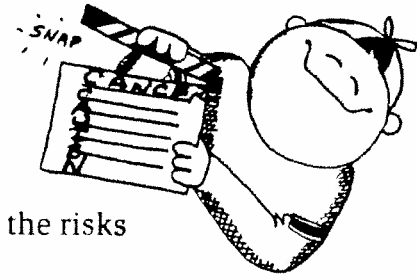


Reteaching Activity 14-3
