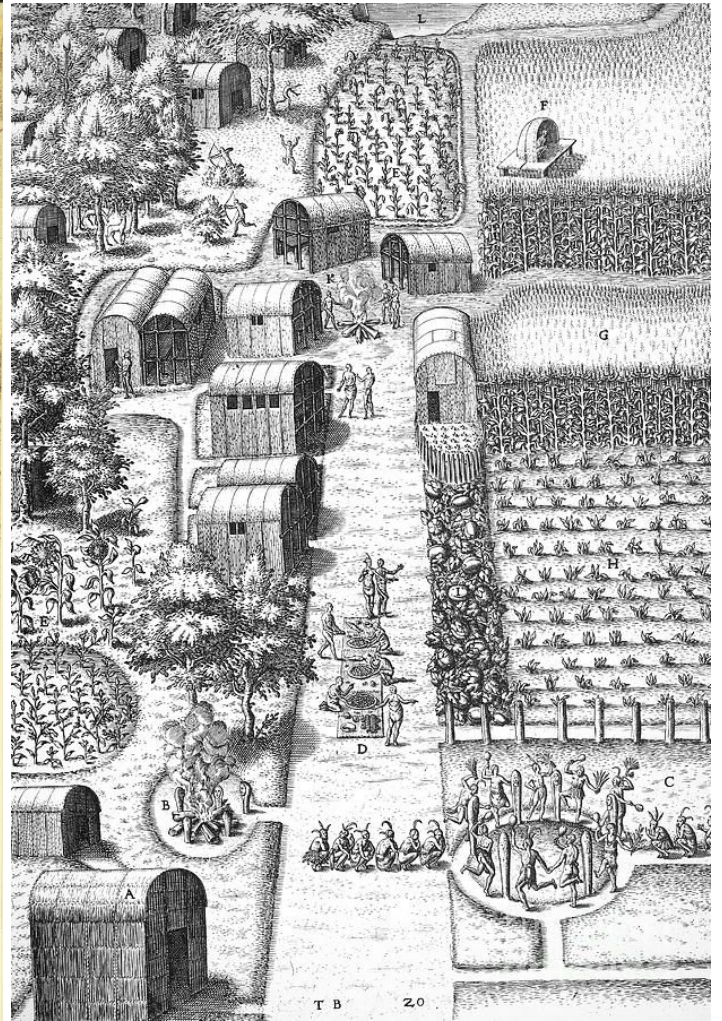


Look at the scene depicted below. It is the town of Secoton. Notice the differences and similarities, then answer the questions.

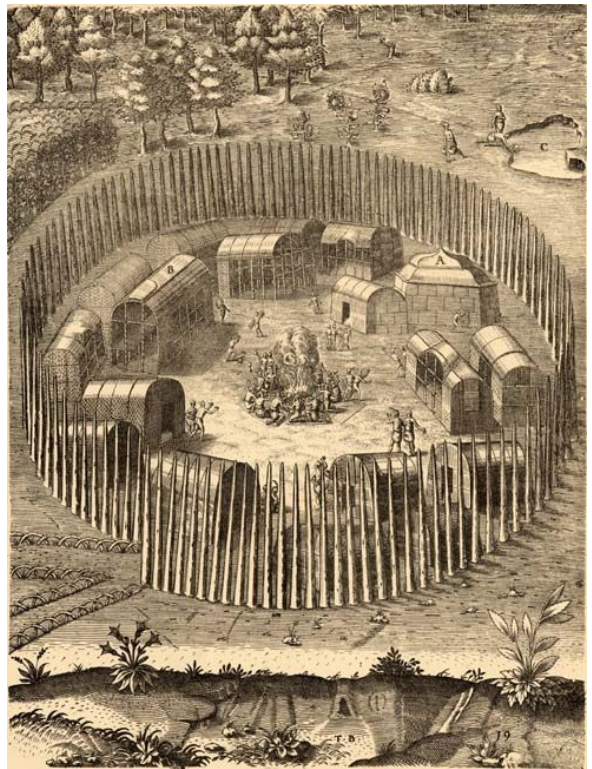
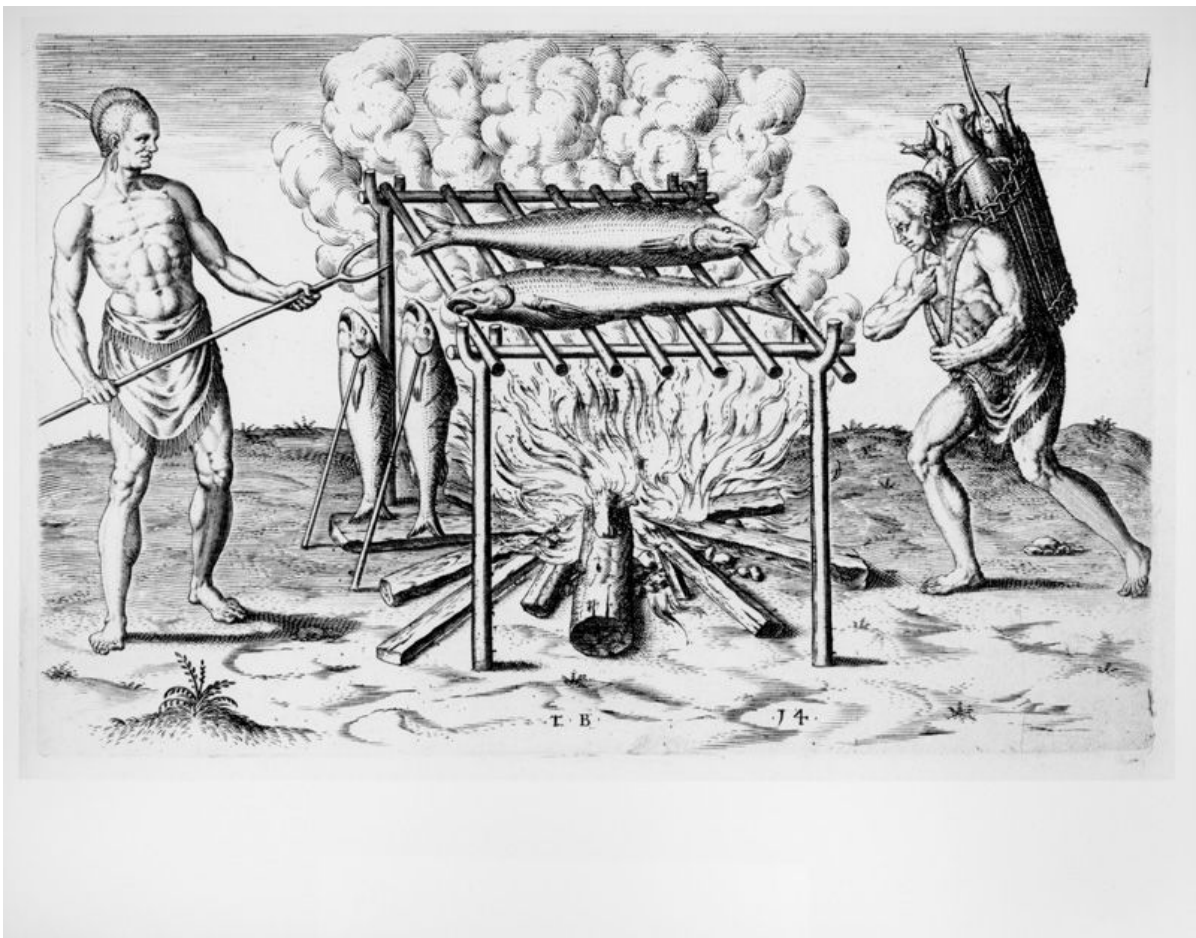
