## Winter Scene

1. Using the Shape tools, build a winter scene.
a. Snowman - Using the circle tool, create three circles with a 3 pt. black line border and white fill.
i. 1 circle $-1.75^{\prime \prime}$ height and $1.75^{\prime \prime}$ width
ii. $2^{\text {nd }}$ circle $-1.5^{\prime \prime}$ height and $1.5^{\prime \prime}$ width
iii. $3^{\text {rd }}$ circle $-1.15^{\prime \prime}$ height and $1.15^{\prime \prime}$ width
b. Stack the circles from largest to smallest
c. Hat - Create a rectangle 1 pt . border and fill color of your choice
i. . $15^{\prime \prime}$ height and $1.35^{\prime \prime}$ width
ii. Place on top of the snowman's head
iii. Create another rectangle, $.65^{\prime \prime}$ height and .85 " width
d. Select all objects (Ctrl + Click) and align to center (Drawing Tools, Format - align object button)
e. Eyes - Two black circles, no line board
i. $.15^{\prime \prime}$ height and $.15^{\prime \prime}$ width
f. Nose - Use the scribble tool to draw a carrot shape, fill it orange with orange border.
g. Mouth - Use the scribble tool
h. Use your tools to create: arms, pipe, and accessories of your choice
2. Create a festive tree using the tools of your choice.
3. Use star shapes to decorate the sky.
4. Insert a Text box with this in it: Star Light Star Bright, Please don't Melt Me Tonight
a. Format font, text box, etc.
5. Insert a Word art that says, "It's Winter"
