BATTLEFIELDS OF WAR = 40 pts.

In this activity, your group is to report back to the class about one of the key battles of World War II.

Here is the important information you will be expected to include in your report:

Basic Pre-Battle information:

10 pts.

- 1. When did this battle take place?
- 2. Why is this particular battle significant?
- 3. How did the year (the date) of your battle impact strategy which was used? (For example, large numbers of fresh troops versus a slowly dwindling supply of worn down troops, which countries were involved at this point in the war)

Geography: 10 pts

- 1. Explain the effect the climate and geography had upon the strategic planning of the battle. Describe the climate, geography and weather conditions during the battle. Did the climate and geography benefit one more country more than the other? Explain your answer.
- 2. Did these conditions have an effect upon the outcome of the battle?

The Aftermath: Gains/Losses:

10 pts.

- 1. Who has history considered to be victorious? Why?
- 2. What did each country gain due to the battle?
- 3. What did each country lose due to the battle? For example, human life toll (citizens and soldiers), economical loss, and land destruction.
- 4. In your opinion, how could the course of the war be altered if the results would have emerged as a victory for the other side? Explain your answer.
