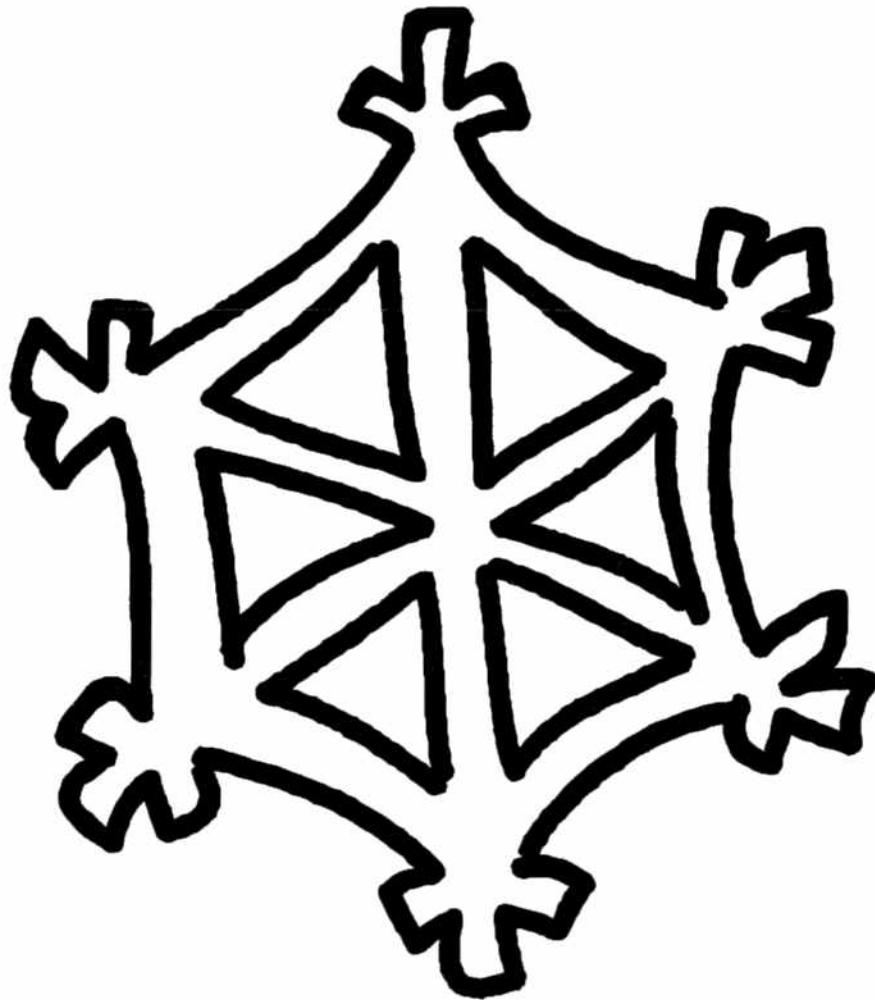


Snowflake Activity

If you are left handed, then you must cut with your right hand. When you are finished, write your name on the back of the snowflake. Do this right so you don't get left behind the rest of the class! ☺
