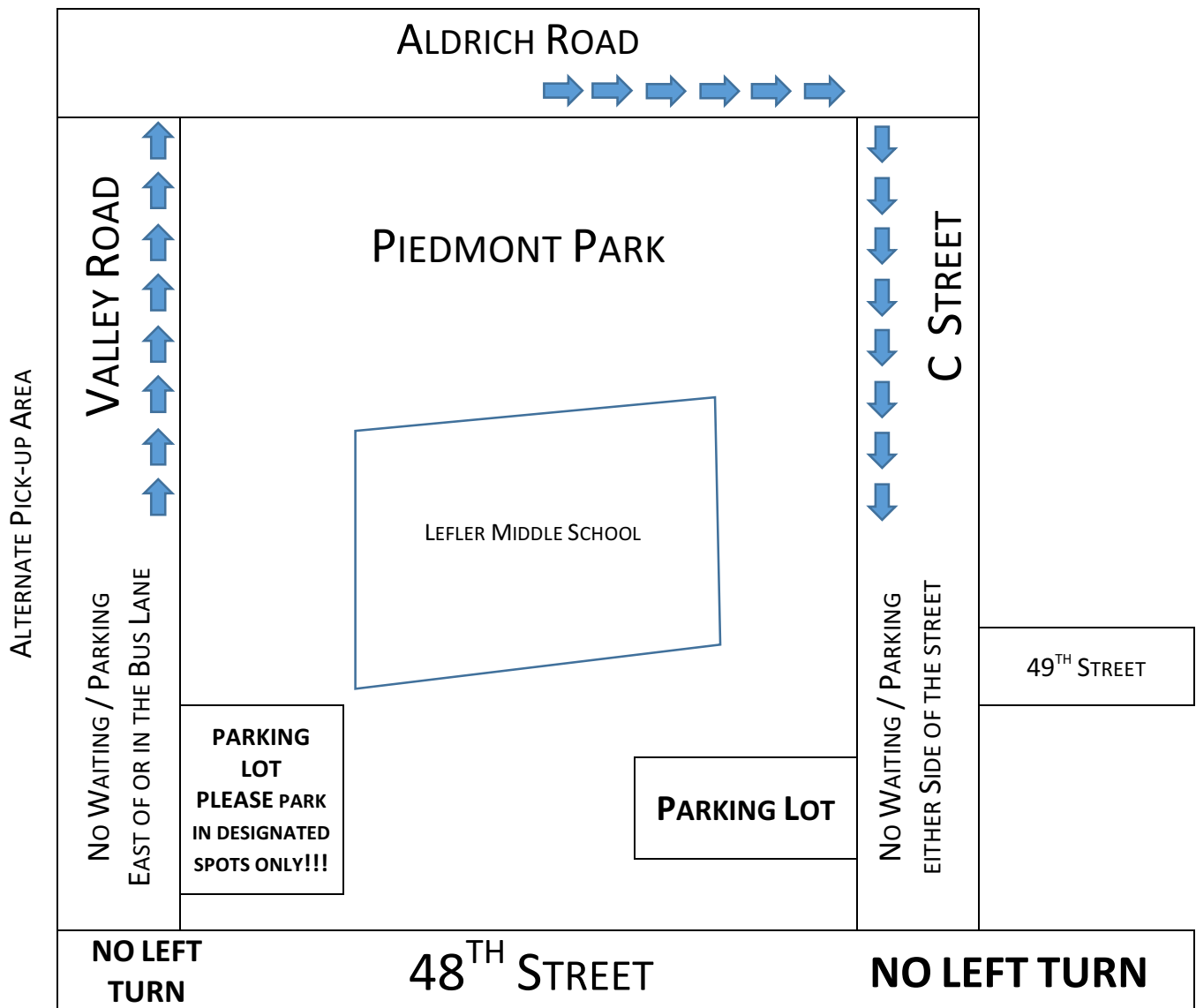


Lefler Middle School After-School Pick Up Procedures

We ask that no parents drive into the parking lot after school to pick up students. When we allow cars in the lot during the after-school rush, we create an unsafe situation for our students. Please follow the procedures listed below. Thank you for your cooperation.

- No cars will be allowed to wait in the parking lot or pull into the parking lot until after 3:15.
- Parents are asked to line up along the routes marked with arrows on the map below. NO WAITING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF C STREET.
- REMAIN IN YOUR CARS. As the car in front of you leaves, please pull forward. Students will wait with staff on C Street until they see their vehicle. Students will come to you; please do not leave your vehicle to meet students at the entrance.
- Please do not turn left onto 48th Street from C Street – traffic going south should turn left on 49th Street.
- At 3:15 students will be brought back into the building and parents will need to pull into the lot for pick up.
- We recommend 7th & 8th graders be picked up on Valley Road unless they have a 6th grade sibling.



STUDENTS GOING TO RANDOLPH AFTER SCHOOL

In the past we have had some difficulty with Lefler students choosing to hang out at Randolph Elementary School after school. We are asking the cooperation of all parents in ensuring that their students do not walk by or loiter in the Randolph vicinity after school.

POLICY FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS AT RANDOLPH ELEMENTARY

- Only those student who pick up a younger sibling **AND** walk them home will be allowed to wait at Randolph.
- Middle school students coming to Randolph with parents to pick up younger siblings are to wait in the car.
- Middle school students are not allowed to wait or socialize on Randolph property. Students not following appropriate procedures or school expectations will have their parent notified and are subject to disciplinary consequences at Lefler.
- Lefler students walking by Randolph are expected to walk by the school without incident and will not be allowed to stop on any portion of the Randolph grounds. This includes the lower playground area near 39th Street.
