WHAT TO BRING TO HAVE YOUR TAXES PREPARED

- Social Security cards, a statement from the Social Security office, or ITIN letters for ALL household members who will be included on the return
- Photo ID's for all tax return signers (Married filing jointly will need both signatures and ID for both spouses)
- If claiming education credits, we will need an itemized statement of your detailed school account along with any 1098T's you have received
- W-2's from your employer, 1099's for miscellaneous income, and W2-G's for gambling income
- 1099's for interest, dividends, unemployment, retirement, and other income
- Copy of last year's tax return (very helpful), **necessary** for MyFreeTaxes self-prep
- Childcare information (provider's ID number and address & receipts for amount paid)
- Blank Check or savings account information for direct deposit
- Statement of student loan interest, mortgage interest and property tax
- List of any other income and expenses

PLEASE NOTE: The scope of work that can be done within the VITA site is defined by the IRS. If your return is considered "out of scope" our VITA Volunteers will not be able to prepare your return.

This **includes**, but is **not limited** to the following:

- **CANNOT** prepare the return if a **Depreciation schedule** is required
- **CANNOT** prepare the return if a **Schedule E (Rental)** or a **Schedule F (Farm)** is required.
- **MAY** be able to prepare the return if there is income from **dividends or capital gains** or if there are **minimal brokerage transactions**.

If you have income from a state **OTHER THAN NEBRASKA**

- VITA volunteer **CAN** prepare the **FEDERAL** tax return.
- VITA volunteer **CAN** prepare the **Nebraska** tax return if you are a **partial-year Nebraska resident**.
- VITA volunteer **MAY BE ABLE TO** prepare the **Nebraska** tax return if you are a **full-year Nebraska resident with income from another state**.
- VITA volunteer **MAY BE ABLE TO** prepare a state tax return for **states other than Nebraska**.
