1st Intervention – Teacher Intervention

2nd Intervention – Parent/Guardian Notified and Teacher Intervention

3rd Intervention – Lunch Detention for the following day & Student Intervention

4th Intervention – Same as 3rd tardy. (See above)

5th Intervention – Referral to Alpha Administrator. Teacher completes a tardy referral and sends to the alpha administrator. For each additional tardy after 5, teacher writes tardy referral too and sends to the alpha administrator.
