




OUTCOMES OF "SPHERES OF INFLUENCE"

- TAIPING REBELLION (1850-1864): HUGE PEASANT REVOLT THAT KILLED AROUND 20 TO 30 MILLION CHINESE.
- BOXER REBELLION (1899-1901): GROUP CALLED "RIGHTEOUS HARMONIOUS FISTS" LED ANTI-FOREIGN MOVEMENT THAT INSPIRED FUTURE CHINESE NATIONALISM.
