WHAT: Twelfth Biannual SING AROUND NEBRASKA FESTIVAL—for singers in grades 4-5-6

- **HOW:** The music teacher in each school may select 2-10 students from grades 4-6 to participate in the festival, using these guidelines: (If there is more than one music teacher in your school, each music teacher may select singers).
 - 1. Student must be able to sing on pitch consistently.
 - 2. Student must maintain a musical part.
 - 3. Student must be willing to spend extra time learning and memorizing music before the festival.
 - 4. Student must exhibit self-discipline.
 - 5. Student must sing in the treble vocal range.

 - 9. Bartlett, February 22, 2014, Wheeler Central Schools
 - 10. Lexington, February 22, 2014, Lexington Middle School
 - 11. Hershey, February 22, 2014, Hershey Public Schools

WHY:

- To provide students with an exciting and quality choral experience with other students from their festival area.
- To provide an opportunity for honor music students who are ready for more challenging music to work with a guest clinician.
- To provide music teachers an opportunity to observe and learn from the clinician working with the students, and to share with other teachers.
- To sing quality children's choral repertoire, and help districts build a music library of such music.

It is expected that each school district purchase the music to be used to keep on file for use within their district. (The desired goal is to help build libraries of quality music in our elementary schools.) We request that all copyright laws be observed. - <u>Registration fees will be as follows:</u> If the teacher is a member of NCDA, the fee per student will be \$25. For nonmember teachers, the fee will be \$30 per student. Registration fees (NOT REFUNDABLE) will cover registration, a festival T-shirt to be worn for the final concert, juice and snacks for two breaks, a beverage for lunch, and **two free tickets** for the student's family for entrance into the final concert. **Students will be asked to provide their own sack lunch.**
- If you are not currently an NCDA member, please download a membership form at http://www.nebraskachoral.org
- Registration fees may be paid by the student or his/her parents, a Parent-Teacher Organization, special school funds, or by scholarships upon request of the director to the site chair (area coordinator). Scholarships will be administered on a first come, first served basis, with two scholarships available at each site. Please inquire where needed. Students' checks should be made out to you or your school, and then you will send <u>only one check</u> (preferably a school check) to your site chair, made out to NEBRASKA CHORAL DIRECTORS ASSOCIATION. This should be included with the registration form, which must be postmarked no later than November 15, 2013. Only ONE check per school, please. DO NOT SEND CASH.
- Students participating in Sing Around Nebraska are required to attend the entire day. No one will be excused to attend another activity or sports event and then return. It is a full-day package. Please make sure that your students are aware of this.
- The music teacher will teach the festival music to the participating students. This may be accomplished according to each teacher's schedule and preference. SUGGESTIONS to accomplish this:
 - a. Team teaching of parts with area teachers with groups of students from clusters of schools.
 - b. Using the music on the list for choir and/or class repertoire, thus eliminating the need for extra rehearsals.
 - c. Make a practice tape for your students for their use at home **OR** buy the rehearsal CD. (See below.)
- <u>Rehearsal CD's:</u> The CD produced by Choraltech Inc. features professionals singing the voice part predominantly over the accompaniment. BE AWARE □ all the study CDs are produced with a license agreement contract for each selection. Duplication of any of the CDs is ILLEGAL! The cost is \$15 for the first CD and duplicates can be purchased at \$4.00 each. Orders must be sent directly to Choraltech, Inc. Please DO NOT send these orders to your site chair. To order, go to: http://www.choraltech.org Click on the NCDA icon to direct you to the SAN CD.
- It is *extremely* important that the singers have all parts **memorized** by the day of the festival. Music should be started perhaps in the fall. This will help all participants feel success in the day's events.
- Transportation of the students to and from the festival will be as arranged with parent car pools, school transportation, etc.
- Music teachers who send students must attend the festival all day and help monitor their students. It would also help to have parent helpers assigned to help with the students. The teacher's attendance is important because of the ideas that can be learned through the observation of the rehearsal.
- Please note that students will be accepted on a first come, first served basis until the site limit is reached. Please get your forms sent to your site chair (area coordinator) as soon as you can. No registrations will be accepted after the November 15 deadline. Thank you for your help!
- The public is invited and encouraged to attend the festival concert, which will be held at 4:00 pm the day of the festival. The concert will be a culmination of the work of the individual music teachers, students, and guest clinicians. Admission to the concert is \$3 for adults and for children over 12 years old. Ages 12 and under are free with an adult.
- Singers are requested to bring **black** slacks or skirts to wear with their T-shirt for the afternoon concert. Black shoes and socks would also help provide a nice appearance for the students.
