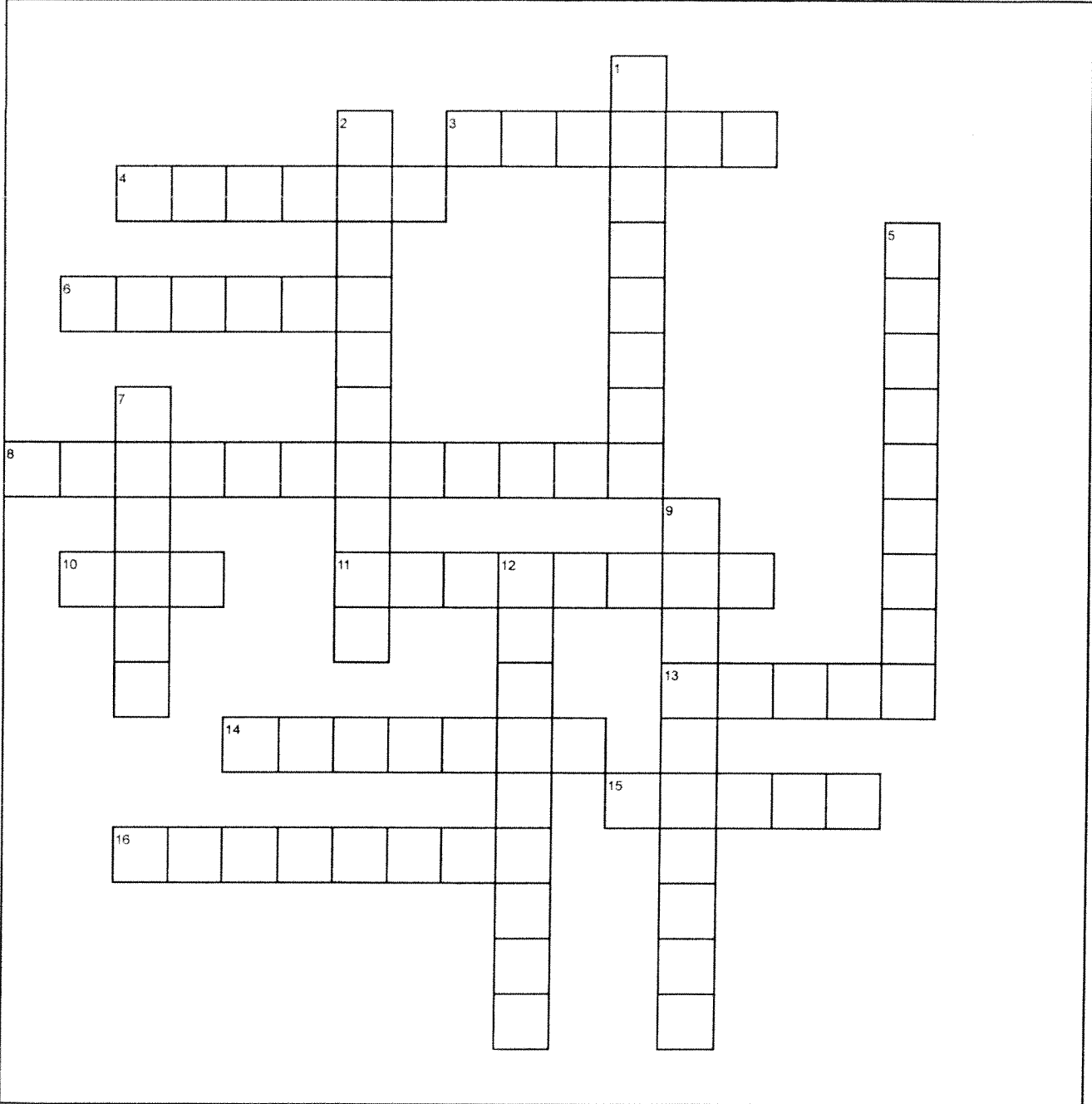


Emergence of Big Business
