

Assignment: Your task is to write a 1-2 page journal and evaluation of your norms project. This reflection can either be typed (double-spaced) or hand-written. This journal is to be written in complete sentences and should clearly explain and evaluate your project.

Address the following questions in your journal reflection:

1. Explain your project and identify what norm(s) were violated.
2. How did your group decide on which norm(s) to violate and why did you chose the project that you did?
3. Name each person in your group and explain which role(s)/responsibilities each person had during this project.
4. What role(s)/responsibilities did you have?
5. Explain the reactions that you received from observers/participants during your project? What observations or reactions surprised you from observers (if any)? Was anyone rude or mean to you?
6. If you videotaped, did you hide the camera? Why or why not? (if you didn't use a video camera, skip to question #7).
7. If you did not videotape your project, why didn't you tape it? (if you answered question #6, skip to #8)
8. Do you feel that people (observers) took your group seriously and really thought you were deviating from the "norm" just because wanted to? Explain.
9. If you were to do this project again, what would you do differently? Why?
10. Why are norms such a large aspect of culture?
