What to Do:

1. You will need to access the site <http://www.211.org>. This site is a great resource to know about. It helps people in the community connect with resources
 2. Once there, type in your zip code.
 3. You should see a box appear that says "2-1-1 Nebraska". Click on "Search For Community Resources."
 4. Once on the Nebraska 2-1-1 page, find "services" on the left. This will pull up a bunch of areas where people may need assistance in.
