Renewable: **Yes**, up to four years (a total of \$10,000). The recipient must maintain full-time status (fall/spring semester or fall/winter/spring quarters), good academic standing and a grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) at his or her college or university. A recipient who earns an associate degree (or credential other than a bachelor's degree) must notify the club of their intent to continue their education and be enrolled in an appropriate college or university within six months.  
Eligible expenses: **Tuition, required fees, books, room & board** and other expenses associated with, but not to exceed, the college or university cost of education.

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The scholarship is open to students who meet the following criteria:

- Senior standing at any Lincoln public, private or home school
- Minimum GPA of 3.0 (B) or higher and minimum ACT composite score of 20 or higher
- Plan to enroll as a full-time freshman at any accredited public or independent not-for-profit college or university
- Be in need of financial assistance in order to attend college
- Have applied for federal financial aid and received your Student Aid Report (SAR) showing an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of 150% of Pell Grant eligibility or less.

Children and grandchildren of Rotary members are ineligible to apply.

## SELECTION PROCESS

A committee, consisting of Lincoln Rotary Club #14 members, will review all qualified applications, essays and letters of recommendation. The top applicants will be asked to participate in a face-to-face interview with the committee members.

A recipient and two alternates will be identified. The recipient will be notified in late April or early May. The scholarship is paid directly to the academic institution on the student's behalf, upon receipt of necessary documentation.

Ineligible or incomplete applications will not be considered. It is important to submit all required documentation and follow application directions.

## APPLICATION SUBMITTAL

- All materials must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2020.
- The application must be typed, signed and dated.
- An official document from the high school reflecting the student's cumulative GPA and ACT composite score must be included. A complete transcript is not required.
- Copy of federal Student Aid Report (SAR) must be included to support financial need.
- Two signed letters of recommendation must be included.

### LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

Attach two letters of recommendation from individuals who have direct knowledge of your volunteer/service contributions. The letters cannot be from someone who is related to you or is a member of a Rotary club. The letters of recommendation must be signed.

### ACADEMIC DOCUMENTATION

Attach an official document from your high school that provides your name and verifies your current Grade Point Average (GPA) and ACT Composite Score. A complete transcript is not required.

### FINANCIAL NEED DOCUMENTATION

Complete the 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [fafsa.gov](http://fafsa.gov). Include a photocopy of the 2020-2021 Student Aid Report (SAR) you receive after submitting your FAFSA.

If you already completed the FAFSA and need a copy of your SAR, follow these steps:

1. Visit **fafsa.ed.gov** and click on "Login."
2. Enter your FSA ID or your student information and press "Next."
3. Select "View or print your SAR."
5. Print your SAR (usually 6-10 pages).
6. Include the entire SAR with your application.

Students who have an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of 150% of Pell Grant eligibility or less are eligible to apply. Pell Grant eligibility has not been determined for the 2020-2021 academic year at the time this application was made available (August 16, 2019). It is estimated the EFC should be \$8,400 or less for the 2020-2021 academic year to be eligible for this scholarship.

This form should be completed and returned to: Lincoln Rotary Club #14, Attn: Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 83843, Lincoln, NE 68501-3843. Your application and supporting materials must be postmarked on or before April 1, 2020. The application must be typed. Top candidates will be interviewed. The scholarship recipient will be notified by May 15, 2020.
