

# ONLINE COURSES

## ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELING (PLADC)



Northeast Community College offers the following online coursework to meet the 270 clock hours of education required for initial licensure of alcohol and drug counselors. The following courses have been approved by the State of Nebraska Division of Public Health. In addition to the coursework, licensure requires a 300-hour practicum (see Statutes Relating to Alcohol and Drug Counseling at [dhhs.ne.gov/licensure](http://dhhs.ne.gov/licensure) for more information). These credit courses may also be applied to an Associate of Arts Degree with a concentration in Human Services at Northeast. Through August 7, 2020, the cost per credit hour for tuition and fees is \$122.00 for Nebraska residents. *Cost may increase slightly starting August 24, 2020.*
