Self-Advocacy Lesson Report

August 14, 2020

1372 students completed exit survey during this lesson.

In the survey, students were asked if they had a trusted adult who could help them if they had hard times self-advocating:

33.8 % of surveyed students indicated “No”, and 66.2% stated that they had a trusted adult in their lives.

Apart from family and friends, 93 teachers and staff were mentioned as trusted adults in our building.

Managing Anxiety Lesson Report

September 23, 2020

1235 students completed exit survey during this lesson.

49.6% of students took exit survey remotely.

50.4% of students took exit survey in person.

Out of 1235 students that completed the survey, 21 students indicated that they preferred to see a counselor to learn more about anxiety and coping strategies. 133 students indicated that they maybe wanted to see a counselor to help them with anxiety strategies.

Student Recognition:

From the start of the school year through the month of September, we received 235 student recognitions from teachers and staff!

Our teachers and staff recognize students' positive behavior by having an individual conversation with those students and letting them know what positive behavior they recognized in them. Then, our staff enters student names into our reward system, and students receive points. Student will be able to redeem their points for prizes from the Rewards Store.

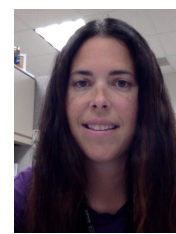
