MTSS-B Common Lesson

1110 students participated in the SOAR Matrix Revision survey on January 11, 2022

According to the survey, **36.3%** of LSW students think that they were the strongest in being respectful this year, followed by **31.5%** who stated that they did a great job in being safe, while only **13.6%** said they their strongest attribute was being accountable. **49%** of surveyed students said that they feel they needed to personally continue improving on being open-minded.

As building, **33.4%** of surveyed students thought we were strongest in being safe. **40.8%** of surveyed students felt that we could use the most improvement as a building in being respectful.

Throughout the last 5 years, one area that students consistently indicate as the area of growth is being **open-minded**. So, as a school we will continue to help our students grow in this area through our daily instruction and common SOAR lessons.
